2025-26 Wednesday Night Pool League Rules

- Six players to a team, each bar has two teams, players on one tea only.
- Picking up players from the bar is not permitted.
- Each player pays captain \$3.00. Captain gives the bar \$18.00 before starting.
- Winning team receives \$10.00 from the \$36.00 collected.
- \$ is for the banquet & expenses. Remainder returned to teams at the end of the season.
- Start time is 7:30 pm.
- Forfeit time is 8:00 pm unless extenuating circumstances.
- Forfeit time can be extended to 8:15 pm if bar is notified that the late team is on the way.
- Must have four players by 8:00 pm. If two players do not show by their game time, all three games are forfeited. \$18.00 is still due to the bar.
- Women are only allowed to substitute for a team to avoid a forfeit.
- Four substitutes per bar, substitutes can play for either team.
- Home team flips coin, away team calls it.
- With five players, the four partners draw cards. The low card is out & the other three play one extra game with the fifth player.
- If a player leaves early, high card drawn fills his spot.
- Both team captains sign off on the score sheet at the end of the night.
- Only the two players shooting can discuss the next shot on the table.
- The home bar pays for the pool games.
- One foot must remain on the floor during a players shot. Any object ball off the table is spotted.
- Eight ball made on the break without scratching is a win.
- Eight ball sewed up in a pocket may not be spotted.
- If the opposing team makes your last object ball, player can choose any pocket on that side of the table when it is their shot.
- The eight ball must be made into the pocket that a player shot their last object ball into.
- Three rail option is available on the eight ball into a neutral pocket.
- Only the cue ball is allowed to travel the three rails and all rails hit must be full.
- No jump or masse' shots allowed.
- Gentleman's slop is permitted if it is a legal shot on the object ball called into the intended pocket being shot at.
- After the break, all object ball are neutral except for the eight ball. Ball & pocket must be called on the player's shot.

- Players must hit the object ball. Intentional hitting of the eight ball out of turn is a loss.
- Any object ball must be 100% out of the kitchen to be shot at after a scratch.
- The lead ball must be placed on the dot when racking the balls.
- Any movement of the cue ball when shooting is considered a shot, except on a break or scratch shot.
- There is a \$10.00 charge paid to the bar for any broken bar cues.
- If any object ball is moved accidently by a player, it is moved back to the original spot by the opposing team and player shooting loses their turn, but the foul must be only called out by an opposing player.
- Any player that shoots out of turn and makes any object ball other than the eight ball loses their turn.
- If the eight ball is made by an out-of-turn player, that team loses the game.
- The first match of the year is against the other home bar's team. No money is exchanged and scores are not counted into the season records.
- All players are welcome to attend the league meeting with each person in attendance receiving a vote on any issue. If you elected to not attend the meeting, do not complain about any changes made.
